What are Open Studios?

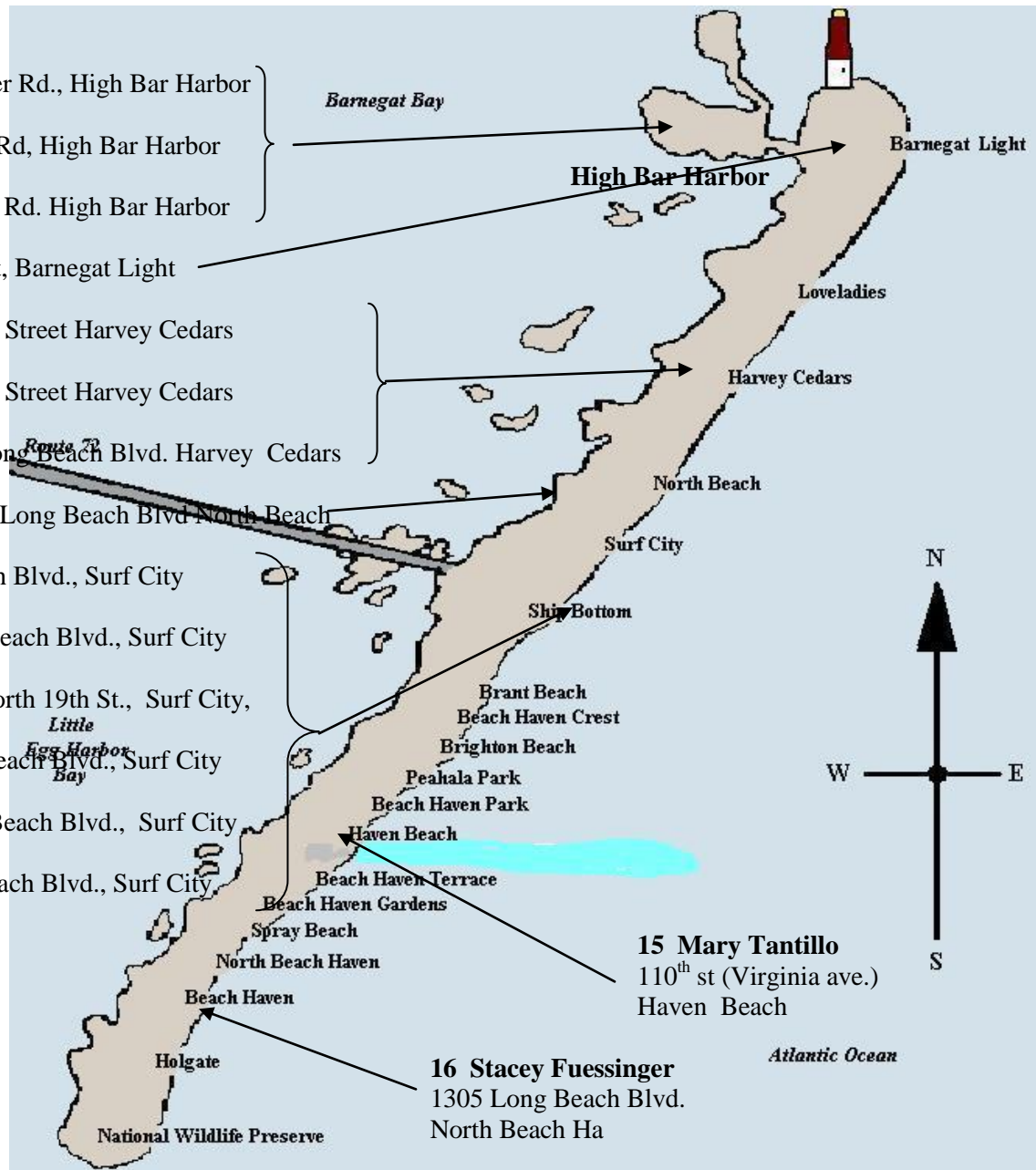
